- Mutual job shadowing for trainers to exchange knowledge and further develop their respective training concepts.
- Experience sharing and participation in specialized training sessions for the educational staff of both partners, with a focus on inclusive vocational training within the dual education system.
- Joint support for apprentices through coaching and placement initiatives, particularly in application training and the selection of suitable professionals.
